# Requirements for Certificates of Competency

# **Small Vessel Operator Proficiency**

- Vessels: Passenger boats (less than 12 passengers), work boats (like water taxis, cargo boats, fishing boats), and commercial fishing vessels (15 GT or less), operating in near coastal or sheltered waters.
- Courses:
  - Small Vessel Operator Proficiency
  - MED Small Domestic Vessel Basic Safety
  - o Restricted Operator Certificate-Marine
  - o Marine Basic First Aid
- Seatime: No seatime required.

## **Master 60T Limited**

- **Vessels:** Master of vessels under 60 GT, operating in Near Coastal, Class 2, or Sheltered Waters.
- Courses:
  - MED Domestic Vessel Basic Safety
  - o Restricted Operator Certificate-Marine Commercial
  - o Marine Basic First Aid
  - Chartwork and Pilotage Level 1
  - Navigation Safety Level 1
- Seatime Requirements:
  - 2 months of sea time on vessels with at least the same tonnage as the one you're seeking certification for.

## **Chief Mate 150T**

- Vessels: Chief Mate of vessels up to 150 GT for Near Coastal Class 2 or Sheltered Waters voyages.
- Courses:

- Seatime Requirements:
  - o 12 months of sea time on vessels of at least 5 GT.

### Master 150T

• Vessels: Master of vessels up to 150 GT for Near Coastal Class 2, Sheltered Waters, or Limited Contiguous Waters voyages.

# • Seatime Requirements:

- If your sea time includes serving as Chief Mate, you'll need 6 months as Chief Mate to qualify.

# **Chief Mate 500T**

• Vessels: Chief Mate of vessels up to 500 GT, operating on Near Coastal Class 2 or Sheltered Waters voyages, or as an officer in charge of a watch on vessels under 3000 GT.

  - Marine Advanced First Aid

- Seatime Requirements:
